Circumstance

Albert joined the army and was killed in action just one month before the Armistice.

Notes

Two of Albert's brothers, Charles and Arthur, were also killed in WW1. Three more brothers returned home.

Their maternal grandfather was Charles Brewer, a farmer from Verwood.
