



WEST MOORS TOWN COUNCIL

This includes, for example, acting as a volunteer carer, friend to those who are less fortunate, volunteer worker or fundraiser. Also, Community group leaders, volunteer litter pickers, that neighbour who is always ready to lend a hand to help others and more!

Or just someone who is uplifting and makes a difference to your life. Why not nominate them today and make a difference to their life.

The two award categories are: 1. Junior Good Citizen - for any **young person** of school age (4-18) **who is a resident of West Moors**. 2. Adult Citizen (18+) - for anyone else **who is a resident of West Moors**.

GUIDELINES:

1. A panel of 3 councillors will meet only once during the week after the closing date. They will adjudicate on all the nominations received during the year by means of the application form.
2. Serving members and staff of West Moors Town Council are not eligible to be nominated for an award.
3. The Nomination will not be accepted if it is for something which has resulted in profit and / or personal gain for the nominee.
4. There will only be **one winner** per category who will receive a small trophy and up to **5 recognition certificates** per category in any one year.
5. Presentation of the award will be made by the Chairman of West Moors Town Council at the Annual Town Meeting to the winner and the nominee (s) with their certificate (s).



6. If nominating an individual under 18 years of age, then permission must be sought from the parents/ guardians. The permission slip must be returned with the nomination form for the nomination to count if this is the case.
7. The closing date is Friday **21st March, 2025**
8. The **proposer** does **NOT** need to be a resident.
9. Nomination forms will name the individual being nominated together with the reason for nomination and will include the name and address of the person who is nominating.
