APPLICATION TO PURCHASE A CEMETERY PLOT

Regulations etc. Relating to WEST MOORS CEMETERY

- All grave spaces will be levelled after interment, earth mounds not being permitted. In the lawn area planting of the grave space with plants or shrubs is strictly prohibited.
- Wire cages on any graves are strictly prohibited and will be removed.
- On the day of interment, flowers and wreaths may be placed on the actual area and left for seven days. When flowers and wreaths are removed, they must be placed in the receptacles provided. Jars and bottles are not permitted and will be removed.
- ➤ No form of kerbing, fencing, chippings or permanent artificial grass is permitted in the lawn area of the Cemetery.
- ➤ Only one memorial shall be erected on each grave, as a headstone, not exceeding 3 feet in height (900mm), 2 feet in width (610mm) and 12inches (300mm) in depth.
- A tablet or book not exceeding 2 feet in length (600mm), 2 feet in width (600mm) and 11 inches in height (280mm) is permitted in the cremation area.
- ➤ Ground slabs are permitted as memorials on graves. The dimensions must be 1981mm x 762mm x 38mm (6' 6" x 2' 6" x 1.5"). The ground slab must be installed flush with the ground. No inlays/vases or embellishments are permitted on ground slabs.
- Memorials removed for a second interment or additional inscription must be reerected within 6 months of removal and at the owner's expense.
