ENUMERATOR'S SUMMARY BOOK.

READ CAREFULLY ALL THESE INSTRUCTIONS AND EXAMPLES AND CONSULT THE REGISTRAR IF ANY POINT IS NOT QUITE CLEAR TO YOU.

1. Description of Enumeration District. Enter on the cover of this Book the name and number of the Registration District and Sub-district and the number of the Enumeration District. Also make an exact copy on pages ii and iii of the description of the Enumeration District as given on pages ii and iii of your Memorandum Book.

2. Arrangement, numbering and casting of Schedules. Having arranged, numbered and cast the Schedules, in accordance with Instructions numbered 26 and 27 in your Memorandum Book, you must proceed to summarise them in this Book.

3. Summarising the Dwellings and Population in the Enumeration District. If your Schedules are arranged in the same order as in the Memorandum Book, copy into columns 2-8 of this Summary Book all the entries made in columns 1-7 of the Memorandum Book. Then take the Schedules one by one and enter in column 1 of this Book the number of the Schedule, and in columns 9-11 the numbers of males, females, and of persons, taking care that the name of the occupier entered in column 1 of the Schedule and the address as given at the foot, agree with the name and address as copied from the Memorandum Book.

In some few cases, however, the order in which the Schedules are arranged, in accordance with Instruction 26 of the Memorandum Book, will necessarily differ from the order in which particulars relating to them appear in the Memorandum Book. In all such cases you must use the Memorandum Book and the Schedules together, and the order of entering into the Summary Book must follow the order of the *Schedules*. The procedure will be as follows:—

Take the Schedules one by one and enter in column 1 of the Summary Book the number of the Schedule, in column 2 the address, in column 4 the name of the occupier, in column 5 the figure 1, and in columns 9-11 the numbers of males, females, and persons totalled at the foot of the Schedule. Complete each line, before proceeding to enter the next, by copying in column 3 from the Memorandum Book, the description of the kind of building. Before entering the particulars from any Schedule, however, you must consult the Memorandum Book to see whether any entry relating to uninhabited dwellings, &c. should precede the entry from the Schedule.

If your district extends into more than one civil parish, ecclesiastical parish, municipal ward, or parliamentary division, or if it contains a detached part of a civil parish, or an area transferred from one civil parish to another since 1st April, 1901, you must, after entering the particulars of all the Schedules relating to one division, draw a line and write across the page "End of the Civil parish of _____" "End of the Ecclesiastical parish of _____," &c., as the case may be, then commence the entries relating to another division on the next page (see examples, pp. vi.-viii.).

4. Local Sub-divisions. Before commencing the entries on each page insert in the space provided at the head, the name of the civil parish, ecclesiastical parish, urban or rural district, municipal ward and parliamentary division in which the buildings or dwellings which you will enter on that page are situated. Strike out such headings as are inapplicable.

5. Population on Vessels. If you have enumerated any persons on barges, boats, or other vessels, include such population in the correct local sub-divisions, and note in Column 2 the exact locality in which the Vessels, &c., were enumerated (see last example on page viii.).

6. Persons in Barns, Caravans, &c. If you have enumerated any persons in caravans or tents, or if you have been furnished by the Registrar with Returns made by the Police of persons who have passed the night of the Census in barns, in sheds or in the open air, include such population in the correct local sub-divisions, and note in Column 2 the exact locality in which such persons were enumerated (see last example on page vi.).

7. Summarising Dwellings and Population. At the end of this Book you must summarise the figures for the whole of your District. Should your District extend into more than one civil parish, ecclesiastical parish, municipal ward, parliamentary division, &c. (see pp. ii. and iii.), you must also show in the table provided for the purpose the dwellings and population for each division of your District.

8. Checking Entries and Summary of Population. Carefully check all the particulars in your Summary Book before returning it to the Registrar.

You must check:—

- (a.) The entries copied from the Memorandum Book.
- (b.) The entries copied from the Schedules.
- (c.) The additions at the foot of each page.
- (d.) The figures carried forward from each page.
- (e.) The addition of the total population of your District.

9. Delivery of Schedules and Documents to the Registrar. Having completed the summary of dwellings and population for your Enumeration District, you must as soon as possible, but in no case later than Saturday, April 8th, deliver personally to the Registrar:—

- (a.) All the used Schedules collected by you arranged in numerical order commencing at No. 1 and securely tied into the case provided for them.
- (b.) All the unused Schedules in a separate parcel.
- (c.) The Memorandum Book.
- (d.) This Summary Book.
- (e.) Your claim for payment (Form F. 4).

10. Statutory Declaration. Section 11 of the Census Act provides that you must make a Statutory Declaration to the effect that the returns furnished by you are correct, and that they have been truly and faithfully taken in accordance with your instructions. The form of Declaration is given on the last page of this Book.
