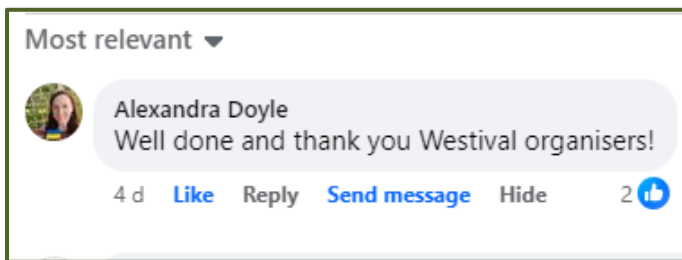


## WESTIVAL 2024 FEEDBACK

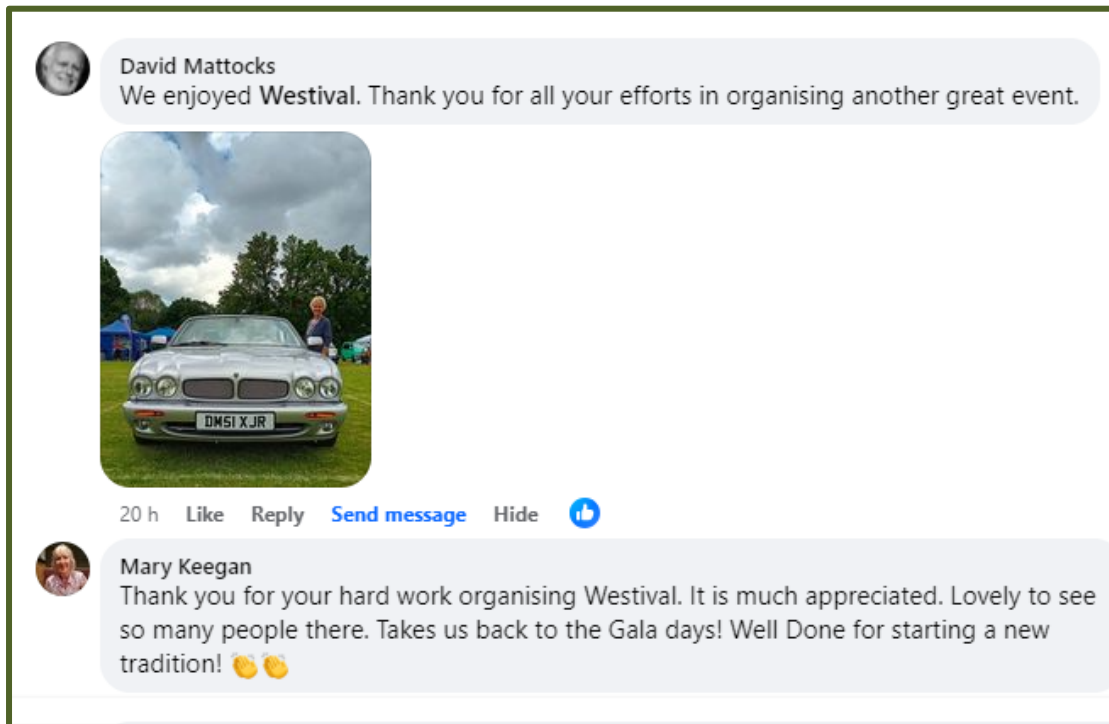
*"Hi Amie,*
