This group was set up by West Moors Parish Council in 2015 following a challenge by the Prime Minister of that day to establish 100 groups nationwide within one year. That number was far exceeded and has continued to multiply many times over.

The aim is to create Dementia Friendly Communities where people living with dementia feel safe and where local shops, businesses, etc, have a basic understanding of how dementia affects people and are able to give their customers time : to listen, be patient and understanding.

We are grateful for the continued support of West Moors Town Council.

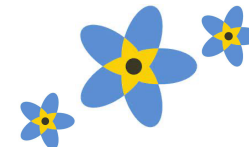
