Circumstance

LACW Ramsey was one of the two WAAF that died in hospital after the air raid shelter at RAF Swingate was hit by a long-range shell, fired from over the Channel, aimed at the local gun battery.

A large number of WAAF were injured in the incident but only Ramsay and Lewis died from their injuries. Extract from web site "Royal Airforce Commands"
