Circumstance

After enlisting and basic training in 1914, Jesse was sent to France in March 1815 and sent to Ypres to serve in the retaking of "Hill 60". On 17th April the British were able to retake the Hill but the Germans soon fought back. On April 30th the Germans released gas against the British and opened rapid fire. Jesse died of the effects of the gas.

Notes

Jesse was awarded the 1914/15 Star, the Victory medal and British War Medal (known as Pip, Squeak and Wilfred).
