Fryer Field New Play Area is Back in Business!

After much anticipation many families of West Moors are excited at the installation of colourful new play equipment at Fryer Field park, designed to appeal to children under 12 years of age. The new artificial grass surfacing should make playtime for the children a more pleasant experience.

This £98,000 makeover was funded by West Moors Parish Council and East Dorset District Council. It was also assisted by a Tesco Bags of Help grant. It has always been a well used park but now it is an up to date asset that the village can be proud of.

This long awaited refurbishment was due for completion at the beginning of August in time for the Summer Holidays unfortunately due to reasons beyond the control of West Moors Parish Council, the delays continued and work was completed on Friday 13th October, just in time for the Half Term. On Thursday 19th October, children from Oakhurst Community and St. Mary's C of E First Schools joined various Parish, East Dorset District and Dorset County Councillors to declare the park officially open. The students present had the chance to enjoy a special playtime after the ceremony.

West Moors Parish Council hopes it will be enjoyed by all and thanks you for your patience. A special thanks goes to East Dorset District Council for their generous contribution.

What's happening?

Yellow Buses

There are many disappointed residents within West Moors since the bus service has stopped travelling to the far end of the village with the bus now terminating at the Petwyn. The bus company tell us that there were deliberate obstructions to the buses by cars being parked in inconvenient places so that the bus could not get through. This caused delays to individual buses which spread to other areas since the buses were not available for their time-tabled routes. The bus company have investigated other possible turning locations in the north of the village however none were suitable. An official request by West Moors Parish Council and our local EDDC and DCC Cllr David Shortell has been submitted to Dorset County Council for yellow lines to be marked in Denewood Road.



Please help support our Bus Service, that so many rely on, by thinking of others when parking in any narrow road especially those with yellow lines within the village.
