The 22-seat youth shelter has finally been relocated from outside West Moors Youth Club to alongside the skate park nearby. The hexagonal shelter was dis-assembled, moved, re-painted and upgraded. We hope it will continue to provide a safe place for youngsters to meet away from local residents and businesses.

It comes complete with solar panels to power a light, activated by a movement sensor.

The project was led by PC Julian Humphries. Most of the cost was funded by Synergy Housing with the remaining expenditure met by the Parish Council.

#### Are we Dementia friendly yet?

There is a combined initiative between 'POPP' (Partnership for Older People Programme), The Alzheimer's Society and the Dementia Friendly Action Alliance. Several meetings have taken place and steps are being taken towards making West Moors a Dementia Friendly village.

It is a community led project, and as many hands make light work, participation at any level is encouraged. For example, leaflets, flyers and any other promotional literature that needs delivering and there are meetings and 40 minute dementia friend's sessions to attend. Once involved, you can help by passing on information and recommending others to join the group.

West Moors Parish Council have agreed to provide venues for meetings and other events where required.

Offers of support from local businesses are welcome as well as donations of money or offers for printing and/or photocopying. There is an urgent need for someone with good IT skills to set up and monitor a website for the group, also for someone to lead the group's informal meetings.

On April 29<sup>th</sup> training will be given at the Council Pavilion and those in attendance will leave as a "Dementia Champion" (able to teach others).

Residents, local business owners and members of the Public service can contact Angela, who will be able to offer in-depth training on how to raise awareness and understanding. There is also information available online <a href="https://www.alzheimers.org.uk">www.alzheimers.org.uk</a>
During Dementia Awareness Week — 17th to 23rd May 2015 the Initiative are holding events in the West Moors Library and the Local Epicentre to meet you and pass on information. Do pop in and support them; there will be a friendly welcome and a cuppa!

## Do you know this person?

On 12<sup>th</sup> March and the 17<sup>th</sup> March 2015 damage occurred to the CCTV located at Fryer Field along with vandalism of fencing in the area.

This act of vandalism was carried out just after the Dorset Police, Synergy and the Parish Council funded the move of the upgraded solar panel Youth Shelter.

The cost of the repairs to the CCTV and the fencing is borne by the council tax payers of West Moors. The parish council would like to identify the individuals shown in the images as they were seen in the vicinity when the vandalism occurred. A reward of £50 is being offered for the identification of any individual involved in the vandalism that leads to a prosecution.
