Legacy Award

In 2012 in order to mark the Queen's Diamond Jubilee and the Olympic Games in London, West Moors Parish Council announced that it would be making a Legacy Award to an aspiring sports star aged between 11 and 17 who is a resident of West Moors.

In December, West Moors Parish Council was pleased to announce that Joe Trussell was to be the recipient of the award which was up to £1,000.

All the applicants attended an interview during December and the quality of the applicants was extremely high making it very difficult to make a decision.

Joe is the National Junior Jitsu Champion and is due to take part in the Jitsu International Championships in Edinburgh in 2013. Joe trains at the Ferndown Jitsu Club in the Heatherlands Community Centre, he also helps to train the next generation by teaching mini Jitsu to 4 to 7 year olds.

In January a formal presentation took place at the Ferndown Jitsu Club where members of the council were treated to a demonstration. Joe received a certificate and trophy.

There was disappointment that we must prolong the wait for updated equipment in the play areas of West Moors.

Despite valiant efforts to secure funding for our play areas at Fryer Field and Oakhurst, the recession 'cut backs' enforced upon the Parish Council have meant that available funds for many worthy projects, including our own, have been hard hit.

We have reviewed our plans in conjunction with the open spaces advisor at Christchurch and East Dorset District Council and a revised strategy of 'make do and mend' provides, we believe, best value for money.

Urgent improvements at Fryer Field, including making safe vandalised equipment, have taken place already. We will continue with regular, rigorous inspections to ensure that West Moors maintains a happy, safe environment for our children to play in.

Despite our hopes that the playgrounds would be subject to development during 2012 and 2013 we are confident that our five year plan of being economical now, will enable our vision of new playgrounds to come to fruition in the future.
