## **VJ DAY August 15th 1945 – 75 years**

August 15<sup>th</sup> marked Victory over Japan Day – the end of all hostilities in the Second World War. While peace arrived in Europe in May 1945, those fighting in the Far East continued until Japan's surrender in the wake of the Hiroshima and Nagasaki atomic bombs.

To start the tribute by West Moors Town Council, prayers and introductions were read by Rev Andy Muckle St Mary's Church, West Moors, just before 11am. The National moment of Remembrance with a two-minute silence followed. Vice Chairman of the Council, Cllr Alex Clarke, then laid a commemorative wreath on the War Memorial.

The CRY FOR PEACE AROUND THE WORLD was performed at 11.10am by the West Moors Town Crier, Iain Mitchell.


Disappointingly, the council could not organise a public gathering or service, due to Covid-19.

OYEZ! OYEZ! OYEZ! VICTORY IN EUROPE WAS ON THE EIGHTH DAY OF MAY. NOW IT'S AUGUST FIFTEENTH, SO WHAT OF THIS DAY? JAPAN'S NOW SURRENDERED. AND TOLD TO "LAY DOWN ITS ARMS. GO BACK TO YOUR FACTORIES. OFFICES AND FARMS." BUT IN SINGAPORE, THAILAND AND BURMA, NO LESS **OUR 'FORGOTTEN ARMY'** STILL HAD TO CLEAR UP THE MESS. WE MUSTN'T FORGET THE WAR IN THE FAR EAST.
